

# Student Foundation Application

## TCU STUDENT FOUNDATION

The TCU Student Foundation is a select group of students dedicated to serving TCU. Sponsored by the Alumni Relations Office, members serve as ambassadors of TCU through a number of activities and functions. Among those activities are Monday at TCU programs, campus tours, alumni receptions and programs, Homecoming, annual fund thank-you calling and other projects as assigned.

## REQUIREMENTS FOR APPLICANTS

1. All current freshmen, sophomores, and juniors are eligible to apply. Applicants must be able to serve for at least one school year (spring **and** fall semesters).
2. The applicant must have a 2.75 GPA or above if you are a current sophomore or junior. Freshmen must maintain a 2.75 GPA to remain in the organization.

## TO APPLY

1. Complete the Application Form
2. Recommendation - One recommendation from TCU faculty or staff member is required. Recommendation should be made by an individual who is familiar with your personal qualities as well as your academic performance.
3. The application and recommendation must be submitted to the Admission Office in Sadler Hall or the Alumni Office in the Dee J. Kelly Alumni & Visitors Center. **Applications and recommendations are due by Monday, October 26 no later than 5 p.m.**

## SELECTION

The initial screening of new Student Foundation members will be done by a screening committee composed of current members and University staff. The committee will review all applications submitted.

**Following the initial screening process you will be notified of the status of your application. Those receiving further consideration will be asked to arrange an interview time.**

Further screening and evaluation, including the interviews, will be done by staff and officer committee.

Interviews will be held on November 18, 19 and 20.
